

CET COVID-19 Vaccine Policy

CET requires* all students for in-person standard programs (college, gap, and high school) to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, including all CDC-recommended boosters. Many countries have entry requirements that include a full course of WHO-approved vaccine for all non-citizens. Having all program participants (students, faculty, and staff) fully vaccinated allows CET to deliver the most academically and experientially robust versions of our programs while the virus continues to circulate.

All students will be required to upload a digital copy of their vaccine certification (i.e., CDC vaccination card) into their CET online account by prior to arrival per the deadline listed.

*CET recognizes that some students may not be able to be vaccinated due to a sincerely held religious belief, a medical condition, or due to vaccine availability. We will consider exemptions to this policy on a case-by-case basis. Students should contact CET's Director for Health & Safety, Vanessa Sterling (vsterling@cetacademicprograms.com) as soon as possible if they wish to request an exemption. Please note: Many locations do not allow exemptions due to host country or host institution regulations.
